Leviticus 13:45 And the leper in whom the plague is, his clothes shall be rent, and his head bare, and he shall put a covering upon his upper lip, and shall cry, Unclean, unclean.

Have you ever done something bad and you didn't tell anyone but somehow just the look on your face they can tell you did something wrong?

In the Torah Portion it is said when someone talked bad about another person they got a skin disease called leprosy, that turned their tan skin a pasty white and so everyone knew what they had done.

People do not get leprosy for talking bad about people anymore, but like leprosy, when you do something sinful, the guilt you feel inside somehow shows on your face. At this point we need to ask God to forgive us of whatever sin we did and do whatever sin we did and do whatever it takes to make it right.

For instance, if you (God forbid) stole candy out of your brother's room, ask God to forgive you, admit to your parents and brother what you did, apologize and go out with your own money and buy candy to replace what you took.
