Would you eat a rubber boot or those blue things mom puts in the toilet? Would you drink what leaks from the pipes under the kitchen sink? "NO WAY!!!," you say. Why? Because it is not food, right? Well, the Torah tells us what we can eat and what we cannot eat, what things are edible as food and what is not. One thing that is not is blood. Just like what leaks from the pipes under the kitchen sink is germ filled, so is the blood of animals we eat and God says not to eat it, but to drain it from the clean animal before cooking and eating the meat.
