- Psalm 18:1-5

**Gal. 5:16-21 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.**

When we can overcome the temptation to become prideful and gloat over our enemies; when we can be a victor without using such to carry out a campaign of vengeance or as an excuse to sin because we deserve it or because “they” had it coming; when we can repent and not return later to that which we repented of, we have become supreme victors with total victory.

The Traditional Psalm to read is Psalm 18:1-5:

<sup>1</sup>**I will love thee, O LORD, my strength.**

<sup>2</sup>**The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.**

<sup>3</sup>**I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.**

<sup>4</sup>**The sorrows of death compassed me, and the floods of ungodly men made me afraid.**

<sup>5</sup>**The sorrows of hell compassed me about: the snares of death prevented me.**
